- Utiliza tiempos verbales en pretérito.
- Utiliza expresiones de tiempo.

- Consigue que el comienzo del relato sea interesante. Empieza con una oración corta, inusual, una pregunta retórica, etc.
- Utiliza adjetivos y expresa tus sentimientos.
- Divide el relato en párrafos claramente separados los unos de los otros.
- Da por bien terminada la historia que cuentes al final del relato.
